

Technique for Making Provisional Restorations Quickly and Easily with Sil Tech Matrix (made from the lab's diagnostic wax-up)

- 1. After taking impression, etch one small spot (2 mm diameter circle) at the center of each tooth.
- 2. Paint bonding liquid on each spot.
- 3. Fill matrix carefully with temporary material (i.e. Exactatemp or Integrity), being careful not to trap air bubbles at the incisal edge.
- 4. Seat the Matrix, only pressing where there's an occlusal stop, so as not to overseat the matrix.
- 5. Mark the midline of the matrix to help orient it.
- 6. Hold for 2.5 minutes and gently peal matrix away from the gingival and facial surfaces, leaving the temporaries on the teeth.
- 7. Use a sickle scaler to remove thin flaching of temporary material.
- 8. Apply tints if you want more realism and glaze to make shiney.
